What is an SLE and who can become one?

The role recognises that senior and middle leaders play an important role in improving schools and outcomes for children.

Whilst SLEs will be outstanding at what they do, they can come from any school regardless of the school's Ofsted grade. If you are interested in applying, you will need to meet the criteria detailed on the [DfE website for SLEs](#).

We want to encourage applicants with experience of leading change in their own school and who may have started supporting practitioners beyond their own school context.
