- Children not attending the above but who have a sibling already attending George Spencer Academy;
- Children in the Spencer Academies Trust primaries ;
- Service Family in currently in receipt of the service premium;
- Remainder on distance.


Regardless of which school your child currently attends, in all cases please apply using one of the following methods:

## Apply for a school place

You can apply for a school place for September 2021 from:

- 10 August 2020 – 31 October 2020 for transfer to **secondary** school and for schools with an atypical age of admission
- 9 November 2020 – 15 January 2021 for first admission (reception) and transfer from infant to junior/primary education

Applications received after these dates will be considered late and outcomes will not be sent until after the national offer day.

# Admissions

- National Co-ordinated Admissions process
- State your 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> preferences – if you only put one school and are unsuccessful the local authority could place your child out of area.
