



Update following the latest government directive

Dear Parents and Carers,

At George Spencer Academy we continue to put our energies into ensuring we respond thoroughly and thoughtfully to government initiatives with our students and staff being at the centre of our decision making. You may have seen the breaking news today about revised plans for the return of secondary school children in January. The government have stated that secondary school children will begin the next term learning remotely for the first week unless they are taking exams this academic year or are classed as vulnerable or keyworker children.

You will appreciate we do not yet know the full details as these have not been published by the government at the time of writing. After details around these decisions are announced by the government I will contact you again before the start of term to make you aware of what this means for George Spencer Academy.

We will look to update you before the new year but please be ready to make adjustments if your child is below the age of Year 11 based on what we know at present.
