I wanted to take this opportunity to thank you for your support with the transition from the school testing programme to home testing over the last week or so. As you may be aware, the government have announced that home testing will continue over the Easter holidays and into the summer term. Consequently, your child will be provided with 2 more testing kits (which contain 3 tests each) on Thursday this week. You should now have enough tests to last until Wednesday 28th April. If your child is absent on Thursday, then their testing kit can be collected from reception over the Easter holidays. Reception will be open for kits to be collected on weekdays from 10am to 2pm. However, please be aware that reception will be closed on Friday 2nd and Monday 5th April.

Please continue to follow the schedule of testing every Sunday and Wednesday evening after 5pm, as outlined below as closely as possible. It is extremely important that testing takes place on Sunday 18th April (or the morning of Monday 19th April) to identify any positive cases before students return to school.
