Home testing remains an important tool in preventing the spread of coronavirus. Please continue to test your child twice a week to help identify any asymptomatic cases and reduce the risk of increased infection.

Your child will be provided with the next batch of testing kits during form time tomorrow morning. If your child is absent tomorrow, then their testing kit can be collected from their PSA or Director of Learning when they return to school.

Please continue to follow the schedule of testing every Sunday and Wednesday evening after 5pm, as outlined below as closely as possible.

Wednesday 2 <sup>nd</sup> June
Sunday 6 <sup>th</sup> June
Wednesday 9 <sup>th</sup> June
