Tuesday 13th July 2021

Home testing remains a hugely important tool in identifying asymptomatic positive cases and reducing transmission of Covid-19. Please continue to test your child twice a week to help identify asymptomatic cases and reduce the risk of transmission.

Your child has been provided with the next batch of testing kits this morning. If your child is absent, then their testing kit can be collected from their PSA or Director of Learning when they return to school.

Please continue to follow the schedule of testing every Sunday and Wednesday evening after 5pm, as outlined below as closely as possible. Home testing is not necessary over the summer holidays meaning Sunday 25th July will be the last date for home testing. Home testing will resume in September following 2 tests that will be carried out at the schools onsite testing centre (further details regarding this will be shared with you before the end of term).
