As we approach the end of term we would like to share with you some key information before our final communication with you next week through our bulletin.

End of this term:

As usual, school will finish at 1:20pm for students on the final day, Tuesday 25th July. The school canteen will be open at break and lunch time so all students will be able to have their lunch before they leave for the end of term. If you wish for your child to remain in school until 3.20pm please contact Mr Hartley, Assistant Principal.

Results Days for Year 11 and Year 13:

Year 13 results day is **Thursday 17th August** and Year 11 results day is **Thursday 24th August**. On both days results will be collected from our Conference Centre on upper site. If this is not possible, students are advised to contact the school as soon as possible to make alternative arrangements. Students in Year 11 who are staying on into the Sixth Form will be able to enrol on the Year 11 results day. If you have any queries, please do not hesitate to contact our Sixth Form team. There will be plenty of staff available on the day and in the days following to support with post-results well-being.

Start of next term:

The start of the autumn term will see all students in all year groups returning on **Wednesday 6th September**. Students should arrive to school between 8:20am and 8:40am to ensure a positive and punctual start to the academic year. Staff will be in school on **Monday 4th** and **Tuesday 5th September** as these are INSET days.

Students must go to their form room on arrival to school on their first day back. Students will be told before the end of term their new form room. They will all spend period 1 and period 2 with their Learning Managers on their first day back, going over the logistics of their new timetable plus other important information. They will also have an assembly before attending lessons. On a daily basis throughout the academic year, students should continue to arrive to school from 8:20am onwards. Students will be marked as late after the bell sounds at 8:45am.

Uniform:

All students are expected to wear full school uniform. Please do ensure you are familiar with our uniform expectations. There are no significant changes for September 2023 but we do want to ensure that all students begin the year looking smart in order to set the tone for everything else, this includes students wearing our uniform correctly.
